## **President's Message**



### SURPRISE!

We are bringing you a Summer "mini" newsletter to keep you informed about all that is happening with the Grand Haven Woman's Club. In particular, we want to let you know about some of the activities and events that have been planned for the first few months of our Club year, so that you can get those dates on your calendar.

We all hope that your summer is going well and we look forward to seeing everyone soon. Please take a minute to read through these few pages.

Ladies,

Our Membership rolls show that over the last five years, 129 new members have joined the Grand Haven Woman's Club (GHWC)!!! It has been wonderful to meet these new neighbors and friends. This has resulted in being able to provide more goods, services and financial assistance to our community and meet the purpose of why GHWC exists.

The increase has required much more time and effort for maintaining membership information. Last year, creating the Yearbook/Directory took 75 hours and \$408 to produce – this is an annual effort. To aid in more effectively managing our membership data, the roster is now in a consolidated electronic format. New updated processes and procedures for membership/renewals have been defined and documented.

Today there is more use of electronic communication and need for technical support. Our website has been developed and will be undergoing some changes in this upcoming year. The Monthly Newsletters and Monthly Notices of meetings are distributed electronically via email.

As you know, once the Yearbook/Directory is printed and with the first change in a Program Date, Speaker or addition of new members occurs, it is outdated. In the spirit of continuous improvement, we are now taking the following steps to be in effect by the September meeting:

**Yearbook:** Information with limited updates, e.g. Club History, Mission Statement, International State and District Officers, Monthly Programs, Bylaws and Standing Rules, etc. will be located on the website.

**Directory:** Member contact information will be distributed as an attachment to an email like the Monthly Newsletter is today. The format will remain the same as it has been. Having member contact information electronically will allow quick updating and can be distributed more frequently.

For ease of transition, the September newsletter will also include the program dates and speakers. This will allow better and faster state-of-the-art communication. In 2010, Teddy Hulse, the General Federation of Florida President, made it her initiative to encourage the use of technology. Here is a description of her initiative:

2010—2012, brought about a change in process. President Teddy Hulse, chose membership, financial security and public relations as her project. Pushing the use of technology, the website was used to the fullest. All materials previously printed, including the "Florida Clubwomen" were now available on line. Workshops were provided on computer skills. Dues, remittance, ways and means merchandise and registration for meetings were payable via "PayPal". Seven "Days of Service" were the highlight of the administration, allowing the members to be part of hands on projects.


### <u>Dinner Auction – November 12, 2018 Meeting</u>

A big thanks to the 146 members who completed our GHWC 2018 Survey this summer. We thought you might like to know the results, so here you are.



### Length of time as a GHWC member:

1-3 years – 61 members

# The question about options to resolve the space limitation issue elicited the most comments. The following is a few of those responses:

Keep things as they are, understanding you must reserve early

Hold guest meetings only 3 or 4 times a year

Eliminate speakers using the screen, since it can't be seen from several parts of the audience...lots of blind spots

Alternate meetings between luncheon and evening meetings, since people who work cannot take that much time out for a mid-day meeting

Love lottery seating; it gives me the opportunity to meet new people (although one respondent indicated that they really disliked lottery seating...they want to sit with their friends)

"Wish our meetings were year round"

### Other comments:

Many of our members indicated how pleased they are to be members. One respondent wrote, "I am in awe of what is accomplished by our club! Our members are such doers and ENERGIZING to others." Members indicated that they believe it is time to give up baskets at every meeting and the Fundraising Committee has already decided to do that for the coming Club year.

Again, we want to thank those who took the time to respond. According to Survey Monkey, respondents spent an average of 3 minutes and 23 seconds completing the survey!
